





Our Buses

Children on our buses are guaranteed a seat. All buses used by the school are fitted with 3-point seatbelts. The buses pick-up and drop off within the school grounds or at the school gates on Victoria Terrace. Pupils will always be given the opportunity to phone home if there are any significant alterations to expected times for arriving home.

Returning Home - Early and Late Buses

There are early, 15.45, and late, 17.00, departures for all destinations, to enable pupils to take full advantage of the co-curricular activities provided by the school. For those leaving the school's sports campus at Dallerie, a handy pick-up point is available on Burrell Street, Crieff.

The number of pupils travelling on each bus, and therefore the number of stops required, may vary from day to day. This consideration together with the vagaries of traffic conditions may mean that arrival times may also vary.

Daily Travel Arrangements

Pupils must confirm their travel plans daily. This is usually done during the inbound journey through completion of a registration form. Should a pupil not complete the registration form, then the last opportunity to do so is before 13.30 on a daily basis in the School Office. Failure to register for a bus may result in there being no availability on the desired bus. It is essential that pupils turn up at the published collection time as all drivers have been informed to leave at the allocated departure time. This ensures that pupils arrive at school on time.

Adverse Weather Cancellations

In adverse weather conditions and/or road closures which are beyond the control of the school and the bus company, parents will be communicated to by SchoolPost emails or texts with regards to any change to travel arrangements.

Bus Charges and Requirement Amendments

Bus fee charges are established on the basis of five return journeys per week. Should you opt to pay fees termly, the annual bus charges will be apportioned equally between the three terms and an adjustment made should the need arise. Withdrawal from the use of our bus service can be requested on a termly basis. Fees paid a term in advance will be refunded but the current termly fee will be chargeable and not refunded.

Covid-19 Transport Risk Mitigations

All forms of school transport will be subject to enhanced cleaning. Distancing between pupils is not required. Whilst face coverings for pupils on school transport are not mandatory, our view is that, as a precautionary step for pupils and for our drivers these should be worn. Pupils will be assigned seats based on family or year groupings. The consumption of food and drink will not be permitted. All passengers should sanitise their hands before boarding the school transport and should practice good respiratory hygiene. Depending on specific buses the driver may kindly request that pupils store items of equipment in external luggage compartments.

Docherty's

Docherty's Midland Bus Company operate a contract bus service from Pitlochry, Ballinluig, Bankfoot and Luncarty, Dunning and Auchterarder, Scone, Perth and Methven on behalf of Morrison's Academy. Using the contract bus guarantees your child a seat and all Docherty's buses are fitted with seatbelts and CCTV. The buses pick up and drop off at the school gates on Victoria Terrace.
